## STCW Updated Proficiency in Personal Survival Techniques (UPST)

This half day course is for those seeking updating training in Personal Survival Techniques as per the STCW Manila Amendments.

It has been agreed that some of the required updating training may be carried out onboard ships, with certain elements that have to be undertaken at an MCA approved training centre.

The practical aspects will require delegates to:

- Correctly don and use an immersion suit
- Jump from a height into the water
- Swim while wearing a life jacket
- Right an inverted life raft while wearing a life jacket
- Keep afloat without a life jacket
- Board a survival craft from the water while wearing a life jacket unassisted

## STCW Updated Proficiency in Fire Prevention & Fire Fighting (UFPFF)

This 1-day course is for those seeking updating training in Fire Prevention & Fire Fighting as per the STCW Manila Amendments. The course will include both theory and practical elements.

Practical session will include:

- Initial actions to take upon discovering a fire
- Correct use of portable fire extinguishers on appropriate fire types
- Correct and safe use of a fire blanket including its use for PPE
- Correct use of hoses, nozzles and hose equipment
- Hot live fire wear in full PPE and SCBA (18kg)
- Casualty rescue techniques (35kg)
- Evacuation techniques in reduced visibility
- Use of stairs and ladders in full PPE and SCBA (18kg) in hot/smoky environment
